This will be achieved by the setting of health and safety objectives in line with the framework laid down within the ISO 45001-2018 Standard.

ISM Ltd Occupational Health and Safety System is to provide a framework comprising of:

- Complying with all health, safety and wellbeing employment and equality legislation and the requirements of all statutory legislation and codes of practice
- A commitment to eliminate hazards and reduce OH&S risks
- A commitment to provide safety information and training in a manner that is easily understood, to include but not limited to; Safety Inductions, Training Documentation, Toolbox Talks, Safety Meetings and Operational Compliance Audits
- Identifying and assessing significant risks and adopt preventative and protective control measures
- Reporting and investigating accidents, incidents, and near miss events, analysing trends with the objective of reducing such incidents
- Ensuring and promoting a positive health and safety culture and continuous improvement strategy
- Reviewing performance by conducting inspections, internal audits and Management Reviews
- Regular Safety Committee meetings engaging employees from all areas of the business
- The companywide Target Zero initiative encourages all employees to participate to improve the OH&S systems to prevent injury to themselves and others through the reporting of near miss events. The involvement and active co-operation of all employees will ensure that good safety practices are developed and maintained
